



IMPORTANT: NOTICE OF CHANGES TO SUSPENSION OF ACTIVITIES.

To all LDYC Members:

In response to the Re-open Saskatchewan Plan put in place by the Province of Saskatchewan and the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health, the LDYC Executive has reviewed the suspension of activities of the LDYC put in place April 9, 2020 and has made the following changes.

- The use of club barbecues ON THE DOCKS will now be permitted with the following conditions.
 - Use of LDYC barbecues is AT YOUR OWN RISK.
 - Barbecues are to be sanitized by the user prior to use and immediately after use.
 - No utensils or cleaning tools are to be left on the barbecues. Members are to provide and use their own utensils and cleaning tools.
 - While using the barbecues members must maintain physical distancing and refrain from gathering on the docks.

Clear signage will be posted on the barbecues. Once the signage is in place the barbecues can be moved onto the docks. Members must provide their own sanitizing supplies. NOTE: The LDYC and its Board of Directors assume no liability for any harm or illness that may result from the use of its barbecues.

- Use of the club barbecues at the Clubhouse is NOT PERMITTED.
- The clubhouse will also remain CLOSED and it is not to be used by members or the public for any purpose.
- The Sailing School for the 2020 season is cancelled. The Executive will be exploring other sailing and boating educational opportunities and will continue to advise the membership of any developments.
- All other activities including but not exclusively, social gatherings, racing events and educational activities will remain suspended until further notice.
- The first aid box has been stocked as normal and access to it will be maintained.
- Due to the restrictions still in place the AGM will not be held at the clubhouse this season. To care for the necessary motions required, an electronic vote will be conducted in its place. Further information will be provided to members by e-mail.

It is the sincere hope of the Executive that these adjustments will allow for a safe start in returning to some of our activities. Further adjustments will be made as the Re-open Saskatchewan plan progresses.

With the opening of the launch many of our members are starting their boating season. While we do, we encourage all to please keep each other safe. Practice physical distancing, follow the safe boating guidelines provided in the Re-open Saskatchewan Plan and keep washing your hands.
